**Seed Program**

The seed mixes listed below have been developed to meet game bird habitat needs as well as CP requirements. Furthermore, each mix has been specially created with species that are tolerant of imazapic herbicide (the active ingredient in Journey and Panoramic/Plateau). Therefore, these mixes can be used if this herbicide is part of your weed management program.

**A) Plateau Tolerant Mix:** Big Bluestem (2lb), Little Bluestem (1lb), Sideoats Grama (1lb). Forb/Legume- Black-Eyed Susan (2oz), Grey-Head Coneflower (1oz), Illinois Bundleflower (2oz), LanceLeaf Coreopsis (1oz), New England Aster (0.5oz), Partridge Pea (3.5oz), Purple Coneflower (4oz), Purple Prairie Clover (1oz), White Prairie Clover (1oz). **\$133 per acre**

**B) Plateau Tolerant Short Grass Mix:** Little Bluestem (2lb), Sideoats Grama (2lb). Forb/Legume- Black-Eyed Susan (2oz), Grey-Head Coneflower (1oz), Illinois Bundleflower (2oz), LanceLeaf Coreopsis (1oz), New England Aster (0.5oz), Partridge Pea (3.5oz), Purple Coneflower (4oz), Purple Prairie Clover (1oz), White Prairie Clover (1oz). **\$125 per acre**

**C) Plateau Tolerant Tall Grass Mix:** Big Bluestem (2lb), Indiangrass (1lb), Little Bluestem (1lb). Forb/Legume- Black-Eyed Susan (2oz), Grey-Head Coneflower (1oz), Illinois Bundleflower (2oz), LanceLeaf Coreopsis (1oz), New England Aster (0.5oz), Partridge Pea (3.5oz), Purple Coneflower (4oz), Purple Prairie Clover (1oz), White Prairie Clover (1oz). **\$135 per acre**

Estimated Shipping: 1 acre: \$15; 5 acres: \$30; 10 acres: \$55 (4lb grass, 1lb forb)



The Pollinator mix includes native flowers that provide the nectar and pollen needed by bees, butterflies, and other beneficial insects. In addition, it includes important host plants that provide larval food for butterflies and moths. The Pollinator mixes have been developed to include species that bloom during the three bloom periods: April-June, June-July, and August-October.



**D) Conservation Cover Pollinator Mix:** Grass - Little Bluestem (1lb), Sideoats Grama (0.5lb). Forb/Legume (ounces) - Foxglove Beardtongue (0.5), Golden Alexanders (1), Ohio Spiderwort (0.5), Black-Eyed Susan (3), Butterfly Milkweed (4), Common Milkweed (4), Cup Plant (1), Pale Purple Coneflower (1), Partridge Pea (4), Purple Coneflower (10), Purple Prairie Clover (1), Wild Bergamot (1), Dotted Blazingstar (0.5), New England Aster (1), Prairie Blazingstar (1), Rough Blazingstar (0.5), Stiff Goldenrod (1). **\$410 per acre**

**E) CP42 Pollinator Mix:** Grass - Virginia Wildrye (1lb). Forb/Legume (1oz each) - Foxglove Beardtongue, Golden Alexanders, Ohio Spiderwort, Butterfly Milkweed, Common Milkweed, Grey-Head Coneflower, Hoary Vervain, Purple Coneflower, Purple Prairie Clover, Prairie Blazingstar, Rosinweed, Wild Bergamot, New England Aster, Partridge Pea, Sky Blue Aster, Stiff Goldenrod. **\$280 per acre**
